We continue to work virtually with all students until further notice. However, we will be making some adjustments to schedules for Kdg and 3-5 classes. Grades 3-5 will be receiving schedules that reflect more of the concurrent/hybrid schedule that will be effective February 1st. All schools have been asked to adjust grades 3-5 to a full day schedule effective no later than Feb 1st.

Our Kdg team will be making some adjustments to reflect the feedback we have received from families with concerns about the stamina and attention to task for our Kdg students. We have some parameters from our school system that we must adhere to but we are working to make it better for our students. Please be patient with us as we make the adjustments. The teachers are working on the adjustments and will share once finalized.

Happy New Year! We all have high hopes for 2021 to be a better year regarding the global pandemic we are currently experiencing! As you know, CCPS has decided to postpone the hybrid plan until further notice due to rising Covid numbers.

I will continue to send a letter when students or staff are tested positive for Covid. It is a way to keep you informed. Moving forward, I will include the number of staff or students who tested positive. We have protocols that we follow within our school and the letter is one part of that protocol.
